SUBJECT:- WAIVING OFF RECOVERY OF OUTSTANDING BALANCES OF
LOANS & ADVANCES TO GOVERNMENT SERVANTS.


Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to say that keeping in view grievances and financial hardship of dependants of deceased Government of Sindh, employees, Government of Sindh have been pleased to decide that Government Servants in BPS-I to BPS-15 who have were/are granted House Building/House Purchase/Motor car/Motor Cycle and 25-Cycle Advances under General Financial Rules and who died/die while in Service, the outstanding amount of these advances would stand waived off.

2/- As far the cases of Government Servants in BPS-16 and above who died/die while in service, following formula has been prescribed for waiving-off outstanding loans against them :-

- i) 50% of recovery of the amount may be waived on the death of an employee;
- ii) Recovery of interest on entire amount may be waived; and


- iii) Cases for Waiving-Off recoveries as in (i) and (ii) above referred to Finance Department through a prescribed proforma (to be laid down by Finance Department).
