OFFICE MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: REMOVAL OF ANOMALIES.

I am directed to refer to this department's O.M. No. FD/SR-I/1(32)/05. dated 14.07.2005 and to state that Anomaly Committee was constituted in the Finance Department to resolve the issues created on introduction of Revision of Basic Pay Scale, 2005. The Government of Sindh has now decided the following issues and clarified on the recommendations of the Anomaly Committee for guidance and necessary action accordingly :-

I) Additional Charge Allowance / Special Pay on current charge

S.#	ANOMALY	CLARIFICATION
01.	Where the additional charge is held of a higher post, additional pay is allowed @ 20% of the presumptive pay of the second post, subject to the maximum of Rs.220/- p.m. for a period of first four months and for the next four months the additional pay is allowed @ 10% of the presumptive pay subject to maximum of Rs.220/ p.m.	Additional charge / special pay of higher post has been discontinued w.e.f 14.02.2007, however, the facility of higher post pay earlier introduced in pursuance of the orders of High Court will continue and replace it.
02.	Where the additional charge is held of an equivalent or identical post, the additional pay is admissible @ 10% of presumptive pay for the entire period of eight (08) months.	In revised pay scale of 2005, the rates for special pay on current charge / special allowance on additional charge were enhanced to 20% so as to bring them in agreement with the new rates, the committee approved that "Where the Additional Charge is held of an equivalent or identical post, the additional pay is admissible @ 20% of presumptive pay for the entire period till he holds the charge subject to maximum of Rs.6000/- p.m".
03.	Where the additional charge is held of a lower post, additional pay for only first four months will be allowed @ 10% and for the next four months no additional pay is admissible.	It is discontinued w.i.e as it is no more in practice that additional charge is held of a lower post.
